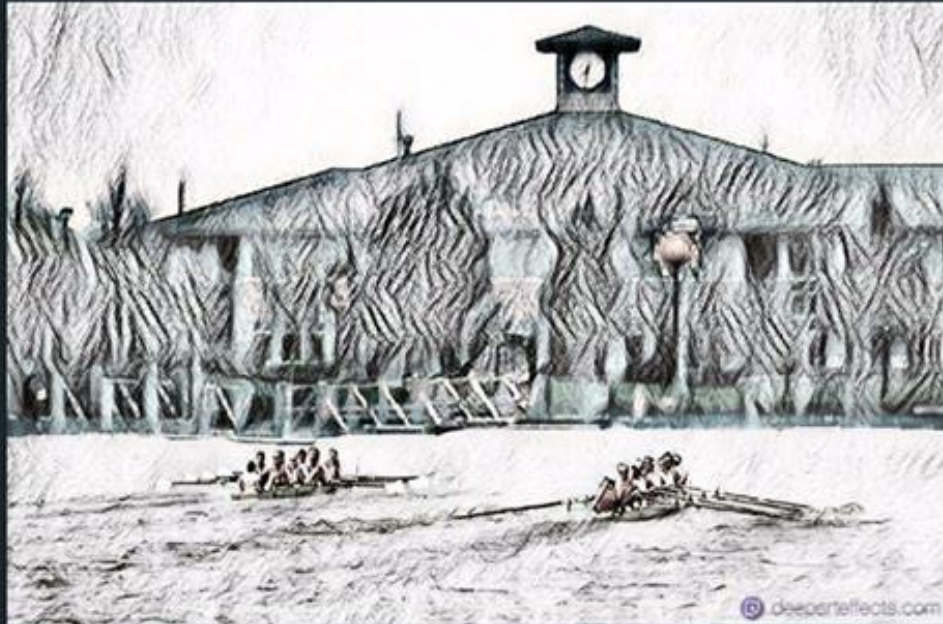


HENLEY ON BOARDMAN



TRAVERSE AREA COMMUNITY ROWING Traverse City, MI

- Overview -

Henley on the Boardman is hosted by Traverse Area Community Rowing (TACR) on Boardman Lake. The race launch location is at Hull Park in Traverse City. The race starts at around the midpoint of Boardman Lake and boats race "Henley Style," North, approximately 1k.

- Races -

Henley style racing

Rowers can select from 3 boat types for races: 8+, 4's or 1x and will be asked to choose to race in either the Advanced or Recreational category. Those rowing in 8's recreationally will row by 6's. Boat line-ups for 8's and 4's will be drawn randomly.

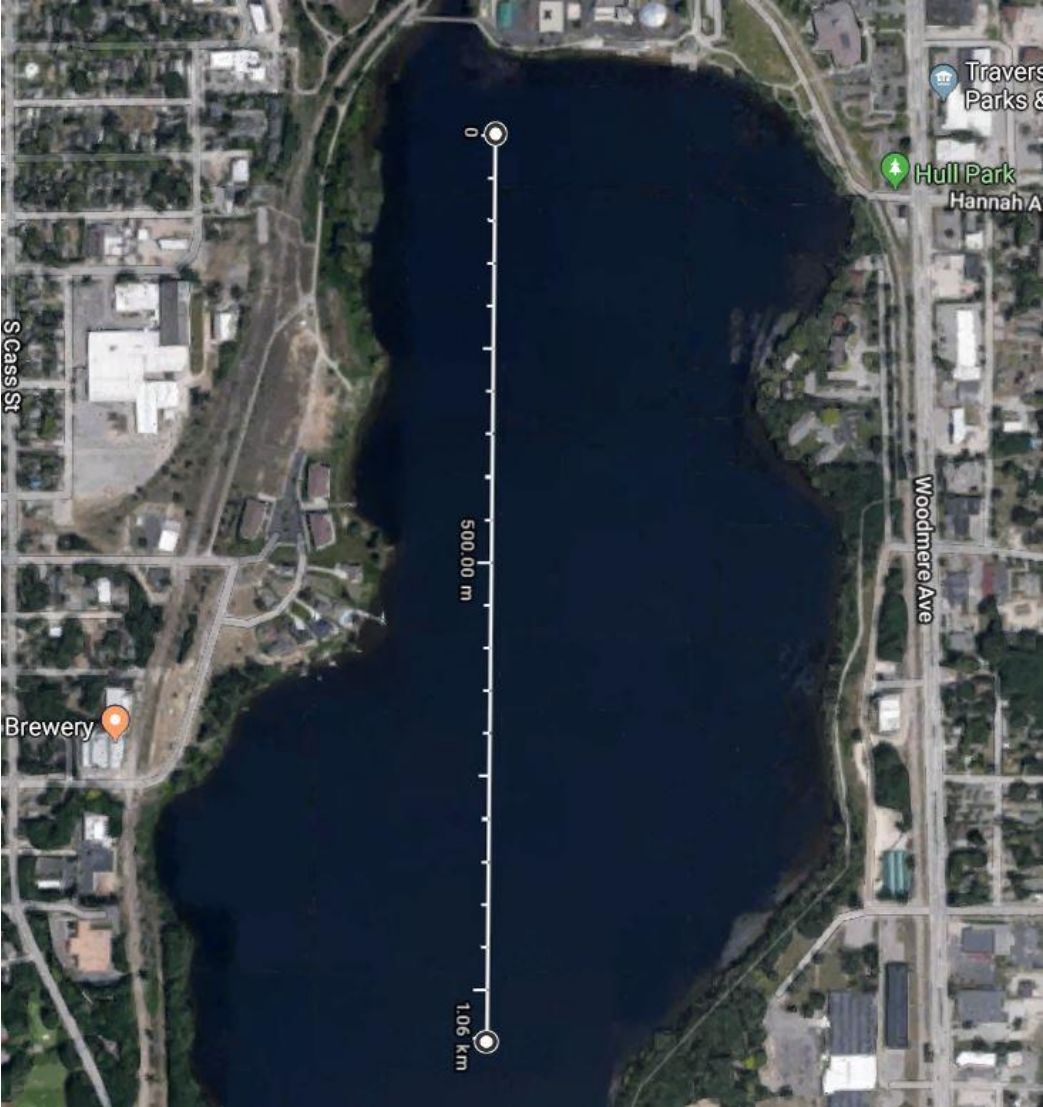

- Boating Line ups -

Boating line-ups will be selected at 9:00 am.

- Race Course -

The Henley Style course will have buoys on the outside corners of the 1k course. Boats will race side by side on the course, with NO buoys separating the two boats.



- EVENT LIST -

The following events will be included in the regatta. The event schedule is subject to change, depending on the number of entries in each event. There will 6 races for each group with allowing 8 minutes/race.

Race Groups

Group 1 (8's) - Assume there are 8 boats divided evenly between Novice and Advanced. (4 Boats Novice, 4 boats Advance)

Race1: Novice A vs Novice B

Race 2: Novice C vs Novice D

Race 3: Winners from Race 1 & Race 2

Race 4: Advance A vs Advance B

Race 5: Advance C vs Advance D

Race 6: Winners from Race 4 & 5

Group 2 (4's) - Assume there are 8 boats divided evenly between Novice and Advanced. (4 Boats Novice, 4 boats Advance)

Race1: Novice A vs Novice B

Race 2: Novice C vs Novice D

Race 3: Winners from Race 1 & Race 2

Race 4: Advance A vs Advance B

Race 5: Advance C vs Advance D

Race 6: Winners from Race 4 & 5

Group 3 (1x) Assume there are 8 boats divided evenly between Novice and Advanced. (4 Boats Novice, 4 boats Advance)

Race1: Novice A vs Novice B

Race 2: Novice C vs Novice D

Race 3: Winners from Race 1 & Race 2

Race 4: Advance A vs Advance B

Race 5: Advance C vs Advance D

Race 6: Winners from Race 4 & 5

The above race format will take ~ 3 hours. Total number of athletes participating: 64 if those rowing in Group 1 also row in Group's 2 & 3. 104 participants possible if rowers limited to just one group for racing.
